ONE-YEAR APPOINTMENT

- One-year appointment available as Emergency Care Policy Fellow at HHS Office of the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR).
- Opportunity to engage in collaborative emergency care and disaster preparedness policy development with medical professionals in the HHS Emergency Care Coordination Center (ECCC).
- ECCC seeks candidates with an interest and expertise in emergency medicine, public health emergency preparedness and response, or emergency medical services.
- Full-time position during a one-year period to begin January 2010.
- Position located within U.S. Department of Health and Human Services in Washington, DC.
- A \$50,000 stipend to cover partial salary is provided.
- Fellow's sponsoring institution provides additional salary and other employee benefits.
- Opportunity to work clinically in DC area emergency department.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Mid-level faculty in Emergency Medicine (minimum 5 years post residency)
- Completion of ACGME emergency medicine residency and recommended ABEM/ABOEM board certification
- Full-time appointment at academic institution
- Support letter from Fellow's sponsoring institution

- Conduct research with possible submission as a manuscript for peer-reviewed publication; alternative would be a ready-to-be-published by HHS manual, curriculum, or web-based resource. Emphasis on creation of information to share with the profession and/or stakeholders as a result of fellowship time/mentoring opportunities
